Dear Parents and Carers

As you may have seen on our Facebook page or in the media, yesterday the Premier announced although all public schools will remain open until the end of term, families are strongly encouraged to keep their children at home if they are able to.

For our school that means:

Monday 30 March to Friday 3 April

- All children who need to attend school will be taught as closely to their regular program as possible.

Final week of Term – Monday 6 April to Thursday 9 April

- Students who need to attend will do educational activities such as social games and educational websites, but not taught normal lessons.
- Teachers and education assistants will prepare teaching programs for Term 2 in paper and electronic formats and select websites for students to do during at home learning.

Term 2 – commencing Tuesday 28 April

- At this stage, arrangements for Term 2 have not been finalised. The State Government is working on developing a longer term education model for Term 2 and beyond in response to COVID-19.
